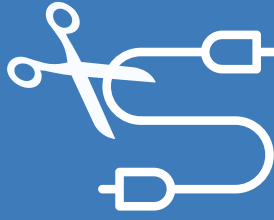


Time to Cut the Cord!

1 Start with a Streaming Device

If you don't already have a smart TV or streaming device, the following devices work great

- Fire TV Stick 3rd Generation

- Fire TV Stick 4K

This version IS 4K HD.
- Fire TV Stick 4K Max*

*This version IS 4K HD. This device is Wi-Fi 6 compatible and will benefit from Aerwave's cutting-edge Wi-Fi 6 network installed on property.

- Chromecast 3rd Generation
